## ARCHAEOLOGICAL TEST PITS IN MARCHAM

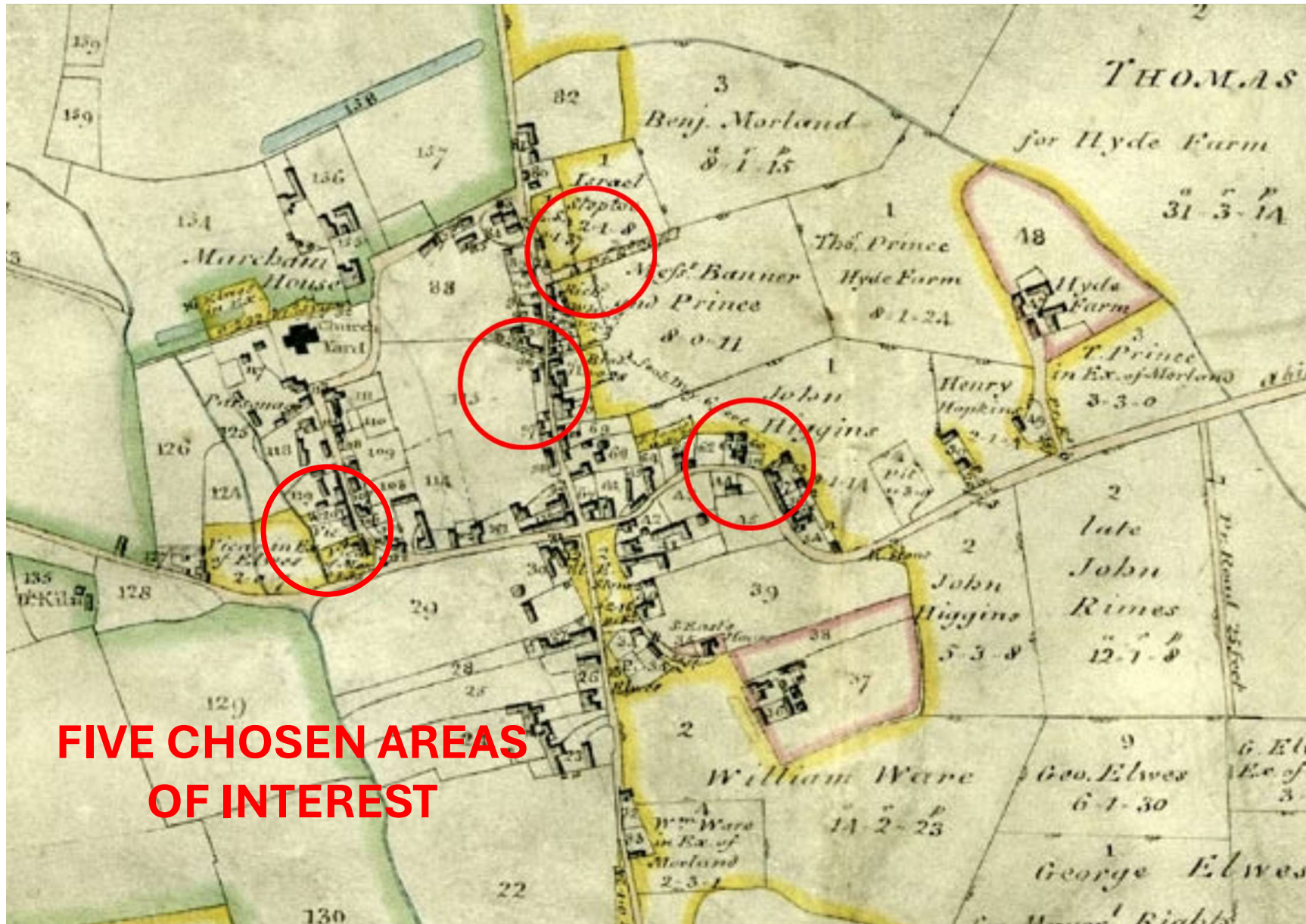

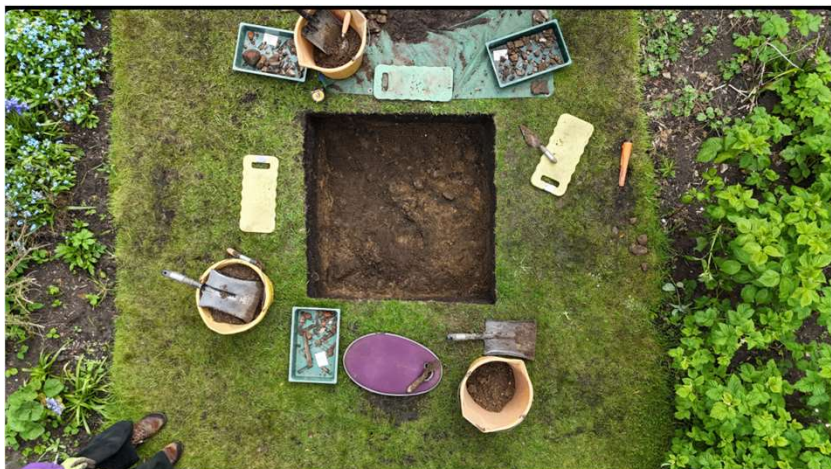
